The Hult Prize SBSC is a platform for SBSC students for participating in the Hult Prize Global Competition. We encourage young individuals to imbibe social entrepreneurship skills. We bridge the gap between ideating a challenge-based startup and providing the platform to exhibit it to the world in a unique way.

- **Humans of Purpose:** In an endeavour to advance the freewheeler thinking and the layout of change producers, Hult Prize, SBSC hosted 'Humans of Purpose', a series of Instagram Live sessions that revolve around the world of entrepreneurship and beyond. The society invited—Mr. Avelo Roy (Kolkata Ventures) who has been engaged in 500+ speaking sessions in US and India, Startup America, Invest India and more. He also has 1800+ start-up mentees across the world including India, US, China and Canada. The session received an audience of over 70+ students who eagerly participated and engaged with the speaker. - **ATARAXIA' 22:** Hult Prize SBSC, in collaboration with the Supply Chain Management Cell successfully conducted Ataraxia'22 on 14th November, 2022. Ataraxia'22 was a competition focusing on bringing failed companies back to life, consisting of 3 Rounds. The first round was an Online Quiz round, where the top 15 teams qualified for the next round on the basis of speed and accuracy. The second round was the Auction round where the qualified teams had to bid on failed startups/companies and the top 5 teams with highest base points qualified for the final round. The final round was a presentation round where the shortlisted teams gave presentation on how to revive one of the companies they bought. The event received 17000+ impressions and closed about 200 Registrations. Date: 14th November, 2022 (Offline)
- **ENCODE (The Internship Cell):** Encode – The Internship Cell stands through its existence under the shadow guidance of the Centre for Skill Development of the college. Encode trusts every individual to pillar on a platform to understand one 's potential and work towards the achievement of one 's goals. We at Encode endure with an aim to provide the students with some substantial real-life opportunities by associating enriching internships which help them grab their share in the corporate world. We also assist the students 'skill sets by organizing various workshops and seminars on relevant topics.

- **Online talk on the topic “Live and Dress Sustainably:** On the occasion of World Environment Day on June 05, 2022, Harithkram organised an online talk on the topic –Live and Dress Sustainably. Ms. Isha, a NIFT-Gandhinagar graduate and a Slow Fashion Advocate, interacted with an enthusiastic audience comprising students and faculty, and provided deep insights on sustainable clothing and eco-friendly lifestyle.
- **31-Day Plastic Free Challenge:** Harithkram participated in the 31-Day Plastic Free Challenge in the month of July. Harithkram supported this project of Plastic Free July®, a worldwide organisation that works towards reducing plastic waste, by urging everyone to join in. We took the initiative to start tracing our plastic footprints and then make attempts to mitigate its impact to unburden the only planet that we inhabit and inherit, i.e., planet earth.
- **11th Foundation Day:** Harithkram celebrated its 11th Foundation Day on September 07, 2022. All the members of Harithkram took the Eco-Pledge for a future in which all of us can live in harmony with nature.
- **4th International Conference on Sustainability Education, 2022:** On September 9-10, 2022, some members of H3a3rithkram got the golden opportunity to attend the 4th International Conference on Sustainability Education, 2022. It was indeed an eye-opener, as it provided information aplenty about sustainability programmes all across the globe. Dr. V.A.V. Raman, the staff advisor of Harithkram, was one of the panelists in the session on “Higher Education” conducted by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP).
- **Green Team Visit to Jahanpanah City Forest:** On November 05, 2023, the green team visited the Jahanpanah City Forest located in South Delhi, between G.K. II and Chirag Dilli. In traversing the city forest on foot and locating and understanding the different

spots in terms of the variety, distribution and density of flora, the environment enthusiasts of the College witnessed, first-hand, the impact of human interventions in a forest, and why it should be kept to the minimum.

- **Young Scientist Workshop:** Harithkram organised a Young Scientist Workshop on “Green Jobs and the Role of Youth in Spreading Green Awareness” in collaboration with the Give Me Trees foundation on January 13, 2023. The drive is in collaboration with numerous other Rotaract clubs in Delhi and outside Delhi as well as various NGO.

- **Project Bhavishya:** Project Bhavishya is an initiative to spread education through their volunteers to every corner of the society, by organizing free of cost tuition classes to the children in need for their bright future and success. Apart from this regular working, a Summer Camp was also organized in the vacations, for the children. The Pawsome Friends Phase 1 was a dog collar distribution drive. Reflective collars were placed on dog that would shine at night and save them from any mishappening. More than 85 collars were distributed. The Pawsome Friends Phase 2 was a jute bag distribution drive where jute bags were placed at different spots to provide them with a cozy spot during the chilly winters of Delhi. More than 35 bags were placed to provide them with the warmth they give us with their presence.

The cell provides the facility of booking an appointment with the psychologist; Ms. Saniya Bedi onboarded by the college committee to bring awareness and help students to provide them with a judgement free and confidential environment that they need to cure their mental and emotional concerns big or small. It may be anything, stress, anger, depression, anxiety, emotional distress, or any other problem. Through the cell website, student have option to book an appointment with the counsellor and coordinating the same with psychologist.

Queer-Feminist Collective

Convenor: Ms. Garima Yadav

- **Freshers’ Sensitisation Workshops:** After inducting freshers from the Batch of 2025/26, senior members of the collective conducted a 3-part workshop series to sensitize them on pertinent issues.

1. **Workshop on Pronouns, Language, and Gender (05 January 2023):** Neo-pronouns and Gender Non-specifying pronouns are tools for Trans*Queer and Non-Binary students to affirm their self-identified gender identities. These are critical towards normalizations of gender diverse identities in daily discourse. Therefore, first in this series was a workshop taken by Senior Member Shirley Khurana wherein she sensitized new members on various nuances of gender pronouns and language.

2. **Workshop on Consent (06 January 2023):** It is of immense importance for young adults engaging in social relations with the world around them to have knowledge of Consent and Boundaries. Most students come to Delhi University without any formal education on these issues - such unawareness can pose a great threat to the safe and inclusive ethos of social collectives, such as ours. Hence, second in this series was a workshop on Consent and Boundaries conducted by Senior Members Aditya Mertiya and Srishti Singh.



3. **Workshop on Privileges/Deprivileges (25 January 2023):** We are a collective constituted by students coming from diverse socio-economic and cultural backgrounds, with many diversities of caste, race, gender, ability, religion, class,

region, and linguistic backgrounds. It is of importance for members of an intersectional feminist collective to recognise their own social locations - their privileges and disadvantages - so as to both navigate and deliberate upon them. For this Senior Member Vaishnavi Kashyap conducted an interactive session on navigating one's privileges and deprivileges.

- **Listening Circles:** Listening circles are a space for the members to gather together, talking about their experiences, concerns and perspectives. This format is an established tool of community building in collective spaces. It also helps by creating a bond based on a sense of security and empathy between members. It presents a safe haven.

- Online Listening Circle - 20 June 2022
- Online Listening Circle - 13 August 2022
- Offline Listening Circle - 30 September 2023

- **Chugli Sessions:** Chugli was envisioned as an Open Discussion Forum where members can gather and share their perspectives on pertinent queer-feminist concerns. The term "Chugli" is intended to be a reclamation of gossiping as a site of feminist community building and a critique of patriarchal notions of epistemology and cultures of knowledge. We believe that it is in small non-judgmental and democratic conversational spaces where feminist knowledge flourishes and hope to advocate for new ways of pedagogy.

1. **Thinking Pride (25 June 2022):** In this Chugli session members gathered together to think about questions such as - What is Pride? Who is it for? What feelings is it supposed to stir in us and how do we celebrate it fittingly? This was in the midst of queer individuals feeling a disconnect from Pride, almost as if it needed a reform.

2. **Abortion Bans (14 July 2022):** This Chugli tried to create discourse around Roe v. Wade and comprehend the implications such bans have on access to safe healthcare. Further contemplating the kind of politics that must be envisaged upon to ensure that our bodies do not constantly get controlled, policed, and surveilled.

3. **Mythification of identities (20 September 2022):** Identities more than often lead to invalidation, ridicule, ostracization and violence altogether. Weighing all of this up in context of the increasing emergence of people coming forward with their true selves becomes extremely important. Understanding that each individual has the liberty to choose their gender identity is certainly the bare minimum.

4. **"Good" women and "Bad" women (21 February 2022):** This was a discussion on how women are perceived as good or bad, and how people, knowingly or unknowingly, make biases, and treat them differently. How both "good" and "bad" women are victims of the same patriarchal system and the years of efforts that have gone into making of the status quo.

- **Film Screenings:** Screening a piece of art targeting a specific cause certainly brings forth several new ideas and discourses which has allowed the collective to come together and

provide with their own views regarding the same. We have conducted a total of four film screenings.

- **Guest Lectures/Seminars/Webinars:** Invited lectures/Guest Talks are a great method of bringing in-depth perspectives on nuanced issues inside the University discourse. QFC.SBSC has invited various academics, independent researchers, and feminist activists to talk about their work with the college ‘s student community.



1. Webinar on Grassroots queer politics and mobilization (23 September 2023):

For this Webinar, we invited Rituparna Neog, a leading queer rights activist from Assam, poet, storyteller and development sector worker. They are a co-founder of Drishti – a queer collective that works on visibility of the LGBTQA+ community and have been working closely with schools, colleges, university, CSOs in Assam on creating awareness on gender & sexuality through talks, workshops with students, teachers, grassroots workers. Having a discourse with someone with such on ground experience turned out to be an exceptional opportunity for the members of the collective.

2. Guest Lecture on “Intersectionality and Queer Legal Reform” by Vikram Aditya Sahai (27th January 2023):

For this seminar, we invited Vqueeram Aditya Sahai, an eminent researcher and renowned activist working on Trans* rights and intersectionality. Having taught at Ambedkar University and NUJS, Kolkata, they were a part of the team which produced the NCERT Manual on gender diversity. The talk was well attended and the audience found it to be thought provoking and highly engaging.

3. Seminar – Women’s Unpaid Labour in India (27th February 2023):

Together, the Queer Feminist Collective, and Ecospire, Economics Society, SBSC held a panel discussion on the topic “Women ‘s Unpaid Labour in Contemporary Indi”. The discussion was led by three panelists, who actively witness how unpaid labor takes place and are invariably working on improving these circumstances. We had Mx. Shweta Raj (General Secretary, Dilli Asha Kaamgaar Union), Prof. Archana Prasad (Professor, Centre for Informal Sector and Labour Studies, JNU) and as a moderator Dr. Rityusha Mani Tiwary (Assistant Professor, Dept. of Political Science, SBSC(M)). The session provided a great starting point to address and observe this issue, encouraging all attendees to take action and talk about it more.

- **Freshers’ Orientation (13 December 2022):** We conducted an Orientation to get the

fresher's acquainted with the space. In this, students from Batch of 2025/26 were explained the history, ethos and vision of the Queer-Feminist Collective

- **Reading circle:** Reading feminist literature is a proven mechanism of encouraging a vast array of conversations between the readers. In this circle, we discussed the infamous and widely text "If Men Could Menstruate" written by eminent feminist writer Gloria Steinem. Students brought forth a plethora of perspectives on hygiene, sanitation, feminist agency, bodies, etc.
- **Resource Compilations:** At the collective, we firmly believe in the ethos of feminist cultures of knowledge – sharing resources such as articles, podcasts, e-lectures, books, documentaries, can be an excellent method of sharing feminist works and create easy access for students interested in doing in- depth study on various issues. For this, the resource division has curated multiple resource compilations which have been shared on our media channels.



ACTIVITIES OF VARIOUS CELLS

Supply Chain Management Cell

On the final day, the team visited Mother Dairy- One of Asia's largest liquid plants in Patparganj, New Delhi. We were educated about the functioning of the plant and were taken around the premises to examine its various components. All in all, Anukram 2.0 was a successful event.



Computerization Committee/ IT Cell

- Established 5 new computer labs for the students of the commerce and mathematics

departments. A total of 60 All-in-one (AIO) computers with the latest specifications have been already installed in these labs. These labs have been provided with up-to-date projectors and the necessary sound system.

- This year, two remote sensing labs and one digital Cartography lab of the Department of Geography have been provided with more than 50 latest AIO computers.
- Computer infrastructure of the admin and account office has been also updated wherever needed.

Career Counselling And Guidance Cell

Students enquired different career related questions and what they expect from our society in the form of webinars, counselling sessions, personal mentorship and other things related to their future careers.
- **Lakshya 2022: Navigate your career. (26-27th September, 2022):** A two-day event was organized to help students manage



their careers in the fields of CA and UPSC through seminars led by skilled, certified, and experienced specialists with relevant guidance and needed expertise. The program seeks to create a suitable platform for all students with intellectual sessions on Chartered Accountancy (CA) and UPSC IAS (Indian Administrative Service) as career guidance.

- **Interview Skill Webinar (17th October, 2022):** An interview skill webinar was organized for understanding the various expectations of recruiters. The session was held by Mr Vibhor Kataria. Students participated in large number and their queries were answered fully.
- **VISTAAR (22nd November, 2022):** It was a pleasant and entertaining game event conducted by CCGC. The major aim of this event was to familiarize and comfort the freshers with the seniors and members of CCGC and to let them know that CCGC is more than simply a cell that celebrates every occasion with fun and enthusiasm. These games were organized to make freshers feel more at ease and engage with one another.

The Placement Cell

The Placement Cell, Shaheed Bhagat Singh College is a student body incorporated for inviting corporates and facilitating the recruitments of the final year students. The student coordinators at the cell are constantly engaged in developing alliances with potential recruiters seeking quality human capital and furnishing excellent career opportunities to the students. Various achievement of the cell are listed below:-

- **Recruitment Season 2022-23 Report:** During the recruitment season 2022-2023, placements at Shaheed Bhagat Singh College broke all past records, making it the most successful recruitment season ever at SBSC. The Season witnessed an all-time high of 273+ offers and a significant growth of 40% in the number of recruiters, as more than 70 companies visited the campus for 80+ profiles in diverse sectors. The highest package of 12.65 LPA was offered by ZS Associates, with other high payers like the D.E. Shaw Group offering a package of 23 LPA still conducting its drive. The Placement Cell was able to bring on board Big 4 accounting firms such as Deloitte USI, KPMG India, KPMG Global and PwC India for 6 diverse profiles. Associates and unicorn start-ups like Extramarks Education, Byjus, to name a few, placed their trust in the potential of our students and recruited from SBSC for the first time. The recruitment season also saw an influx of more than 50% novel recruiters, with some notable names being BDO Rise, Intellipaat, RSM etc.
- **Articleship Drive:** Apart from providing career opportunities to the students, the Placement Cell also hosted Articleship drives for the students pursuing Chartered Accountancy course. Companies such as Grant Thornton were a few among others who



hired Articleship trainees from our campus.

- **Collaboration With Coursera:** The Placement Cell continued with its initiative to collaborate with digital learning platform Coursera to provide free access of various online courses to all students. The initiative drew participation of more than 1000 students, who used these courses for upskilling themselves.
- **CV Vetting Drive :** The Placement Team also carried out a CV vetting drive for more than 700 students to ensure standardization and genuineness of all CVs. To increase the corporate exposure of first and second-year students at college, the Placement Cell associated with firms like Deloitte USI, The D.E. Shaw Group, etc. to host events like Graduate School Maverick, Deloitte- Be the One Challenge, Finspire Fellowship, and summer internships.

LIBRARY - KNOWLEDGE & LEARNING RESOURCE CENTRE

The library is a growing organism and like every year this year too, library has grown in terms of its resources and services. In 2022-23, Library added **1501 titles** in the collection of different disciplines like Commerce, Economics, Mathematics, Geography, Political Science, History, English and Hindi. In our effort to welcome and honour the demand of our students and faculty members, **368 titles** have also been added in our *Reference Section* comprising of competitive entrance books; general knowledge books; yearbooks; reports; atlases; etc. The total **accessioned volumes as of now are 93734**; however, **the total collection of serviceable copies as on date is 68739** after deducting the collection which has been weeded over a period of 25 years. The library is also subscribing to **72 Periodicals**, comprising of 54 Journals and 18 Magazines of academic and general interest.

During this year, another notable milestone was achieved. The data of our library has been migrated on Cloud in KOHA Library Management Software from LSEase (LibSys Library Management Software). Koha is international open software with better services. It is a user-friendly interface. It provides an e-mail alert service, an online reservation facility with web OPAC for book searching. It sends the e-mail automatically and alerts users for overdue, check-outs and check-in. Koha allows the user to send online suggestions for purchasing books.

On the request of library users, the timing of Reading Hall has been extended from 4:30 pm to 8 pm. More than 80 students are taking benefits of the extended services and library resources daily after 4:30 pm. SCHOLARSHIPS AND MEDALS AWARDED TO MERITORIOUS STUDENTS

Every year, in keeping with its legacy, the college awards scholarships and medals to deserving and meritorious students who exhibit extraordinary performance in academics and other disciplines. This past academic year has not been an exception to this. The scholarship committee and departments of the college have worked over the course of many months to teach, mentor, select, and award students who have excelled in various fields at the college level.

Gold and Silver medals are awarded to students who meet the qualifying criteria set by respective departmental committees. STUDENT AID FUND

The Shaheed Bhagat Singh College stands committed to principles of equal opportunity, social justice, and financial inclusivity. We strongly believe that quality education made available at an affordable fee is the surest way to lead social change, and thus we try everything in our power to make sure that none of our students have to compromise on their academic pursuits solely because of financial constraints.

Being a part of a central university, we realize that it is our responsibility to make students from all parts of the country feel welcome and to ensure that no child is left behind in the pursuit of a better future. For this, the college helps disadvantaged students with the payment of a sum of money that is intended to be used for their educational expenditure.

In the academic year 2022-23, a sum of Rs. 17,04,495 (Seventeen lakhs four thousand four ninety-five) was disbursed to the students in the form of student aid. In order to ensure transparency and curtail redundancies, funds were transferred directly to the student's bank accounts. Students from all departments were beneficiaries of this exercise. The eligibility for this aid was ascertained through a screening process. Interviews were conducted in online mode in the months of January and February 2022 to ascertain suitability.

Needless to say, this could not have been made possible without the promptness and diligence of the accounts department and the Union Bank of India branch employees. The college expresses a deep sense of thankfulness to them. We are also grateful to Dr. Raj Kumar Rajan, Convener, Student Aid Fund.
