

In the last year, the college has undertaken many initiatives in order to provide different opportunities to the students in improving their quality of education. One such initiative is the launch of the Gyan Prasar Kendra in the college which is a source of rich content

aimed at aiding the students in their academic pursuits. We hope that Gyan Prasar Kendra will continue to provide quality content in the future as well.

This year, the college has also launched the Principal's Internship Scheme to facilitate short term exposure and experience to the students in different areas of college administrative functioning. We have witnessed great enthusiasm from the students for the initiative and hope that this enthusiasm is sustained in the coming years as well.

Shaheed Bhagat Singh College, a constituent college of the University of Delhi, has been imparting higher education in Commerce, Humanities, and Social Sciences for over five decades now. At our college, we endeavor to provide a vibrant studentcentric pedagogy and environment for the overall development of all our students, focusing on components such as academics, extra-curricular activities, sports, NCC, and social work.

Now, I present before you the Annual Report on the activities and achievements of the college during the year 2023-24.

INFRASTRUCTURE AND DEVELOPMENT

Accomplishments

This year at Shaheed Bhagat Singh College, we have made significant strides in enhancing our infrastructure. The statue of Shaheed-e-Azam Bhagat Singh has been beautifully reconstructed, to mark respect for the great son of India by enhancing its aesthetics with the use of marble and grill. Further, the Knowledge Dissemination Centre has been established, offering recorded lectures that will benefit students nationwide. We have transformed some existing classrooms into smart classrooms, as a pilot project equipped with advanced interactive panels, wireless mics, state of the art podium and seating arrangement. Additionally, we have completed the construction of five state-of-the-art computer labs, providing our students with cutting-edge technology for their academic pursuits.

The college has achieved a significant milestone by introducing and successfully implementing the Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) Saksham Portal for student and faculty operations. This innovative platform enables students to monitor their live attendance and conveniently submit assignments. By leveraging this technology, we are enhancing transparency, efficiency and engagement within our academic community.

We are also in the process of constructing 21 new classrooms to cater to the expansion required due to 4th year under NEP. The seminar halls have also been upgraded with LED panels, enhancing the quality of presentations, lectures and discussions. We have constructed an open air auditorium for organising programs and a dedicated staff parking area has also been constructed for the convenience of staff.

With the assistance of Delhi Police, we have installed a 360-degree PTZ camera near the main entrance of the college to bolster security. We have implemented enhanced security measures at the main entrance and side boundaries for the safety and security. These improvements serve as a testament to our commitment towards providing a safe learning environment for our students.

Matching the strength of our faculty the college has established a newly airconditioned staff room. To enhance accessibility to divyang students and faculty members across the college, we have installed two elevators in the main building. Our library is now open from 8 AM to 8 PM so that it enables the students to use the library even after college hours. A secure and comfortable space has been dedicated to our female students with a new girls' common room. For added convenience, E-Vending machines have been installed in the canteen. Furthermore, we have developed a multiple entry-exit gate system, making campus navigation more convenient for our students.

Future Plans

- We plan to modernize the library, providing air conditioners, separate cabins for teachers and designated reading rooms for teachers and students.
- We are in the process of constructing a grand multipurpose hall with sports facilities like basketball, tennis court, and gymnasium with a capacity of 1500 people.
- We will install floodlights on the sports ground to enhance our cricket and football facilities.
- We aim to make the college corridors paperless by installing various screens and a main display screen near Bhagat Singh statue.
- We have started the work of setting up an electric substation that will make all the classrooms fully air conditioned.

The year 2023-24 was special for many of our faculty members, as several promotions were done in the year. Jha, Associate Professor, Department of History, University of Delhi on the topic 'Congress, League and the Partition of India' followed by a quiz competition on the following day.


- HISTORIA organised an educational cum field trip to Bhopal from 26-30 January, 2024.


Centre for Shaheed Bhagat Singh Studies and Research

Under Graduate Research Aptitude (UGRA):

On the occasion of International Geodiversity Day, i.e. October 6, 2023, the Centre for Indian Knowledge Systems, in collaboration with Harithkram, the environment society of the College, launched the Under Graduate Research Aptitude (UGRA), an inter-college, interdisciplinary competition for undergraduate students on the focal theme 'Ecological Consciousness in Ancient India: Life Then and Now.' Feroz Shah Kotla is a fortress built in the 14th century by Feroz Shah Tughlaq, the Sultan of Delhi, to house his version of Delhi city called Firozabad. The fortress was



constructed on the west bank of Yamuna to solve the water crisis, as the previous four citadels were located far from the river and were abandoned for lack of water. The fortress houses a pristine polished sandstone Topra Ashokan pillar from the 3rd century BC, one of many pillars of

Ashoka left by the Mauryan emperor. The citadel is also famous for its tales of friendly ghosts locally known as djinns.

The walk was led by the President of Society, Ayushi Nema, who focused on its architectural patronage, historical significance, and tales of friendly ghosts.

Recruitment Season 2023-24

The Placement Cell, Shaheed Bhagat Singh College is a student body incorporated for inviting corporates and facilitating the recruitment of final-year students. The student coordinators at the cell are constantly engaged in developing alliances with potential recruiters seeking quality human capital and furnishing excellent career opportunities to the students. The initiatives of the cell for the year 2023-24 are listed below:

- During the current recruitment season, the placements at SBSC saw a rise in the number of new recruiters with diverse profiles offered to the students.
- The season witnessed around 160 offers so far, with more than 40 companies recruiting across 60+ profiles in diverse sectors.
- The highest package (12.88 LPA) was offered by Futures First, with other high payers like the D.E. Shaw Group offering a package of 23 LPA still in the process of conducting its drive.
- The Placement Cell brought on board renowned accounting firms such as Deloitte USI, KPMG India, PwC India and EY GDS. Associates and unicorn start-ups like Zomato, and Swiggy, to name a few, placed their trust in the potential of our students and recruited from SBSC for the first time. The recruitment season also saw an influx of more than 50% novel recruiters, including Accenture, Intellipaat, RSM, etc.
- The Placement Cell was able to bring on board Big 4 accounting firms such as Deloitte USI, KPMG India, KPMG Global Services, and PwC India. Apart from Big 4s, the cell also on-boarded big consulting firms such as BCG. Companies across various sectors such as Consulting, Audit and Taxation, Finance, Sales and Marketing, Operations and Research, Education, HR, Startup, etc participated in the campus recruitment process.

LIBRARY - KNOWLEDGE & LEARNING RESOURCE CENTRE

In 2023-24, Library added 2221 titles in the collection of different disciplines like Commerce, Economics, Mathematics, Geography, Political Science, History, English and Hindi. In our effort to welcome and honour the demand of our students and faculty members, 265 titles have also been added in our *Reference Section* consisting of competitive entrance books; general knowledge books; yearbooks; reports; atlases; etc. The total accessioned volumes as of now are 95955; however, the total collection of serviceable copies as on date is 68739 after deducting the collection which has been weeded over a period of 25 years. The library is also subscribed to 74 Periodicals, comprising 56 Journals and 18 Magazines of academic and general interest.

During this year, another notable milestone was achieved. The data of our library has been migrated on Cloud in KOHA Library Management Software. Koha is an international open software with better services. It has a user-friendly interface. It provides e-mail alert service, online reservation facility with web-OPAC for book searching. It sends the e-mail automatically and alerts users for overdue, check-outs and check-in. Koha allows the user to send online suggestions for purchasing books.

The timing of Reading Hall has been extended from 4:30 pm to 8 pm. More than 80 students have taken advantage of the extended services and library resources daily after 4:30 pm. A bird's eye view of the figures with respect to the usage of library resources and services are:


