#### ABOUT THE CONCLAVE

The concept is to understand one's own experiences or visualize or conceptualize or theorize any one or multiple aspects of the everyday geographies with an innovative and original approach and write a research paper on the same. The teams need to create a presentation and share the experiences with their peer group. The mentor (faculty) is to guide the student team in creating a well-prepared output from the study undertaken.

#### THEME OF THE CONCLAVE

Sustainability has become a wide-ranging term that can be applied to almost every facet of life on the Earth; The term looks relevant from local to a global scale and over various time periods. Long-lived and healthy wetlands and forests are examples of sustainable ecological systems. Team(s) will be informed by email about the acceptance of their abstracts by October 15th 2019.

#### **ELIGIBILITY FOR THE EVENT**

- 1. It is a TEAM EVENT based on original and innovative approach.
- 2. The team will comprise of four students and a mentor.
- 3. A student cannot be a part of two teams.
- 4. The team must be from the same institution.
- 5. Mentor must be a teacher of Geography (One mentor one team)
- 6. Students must be studying Geography as a subject in any of the Bachelor's Programme.

#### IMPORTANT GUIDELINES

- 1. Registration and Submission of Abstracts (max. word limit 300) via Google form/link
- 2. Acceptance of Abstracts for participation
- 3. Review stages regarding progress of the study. (Review stages are compulsory to move further. At each stage Mentor's approval to the work is mandatory.)
- 1. First Review on the work progress
- 2. Second Review on the work progress
- 4. Students will present their findings using PPT on the day of event. The mentors are also invited to join the event along with their team.
- 5. Full paper submission (in the enclosed format)

- a) Along with certificate of originality (no plagiarism) in hard copy.
- b) Text limit: 5000 words (max.)
- c) Illustrations / tables/map/photographs to be included in the paper.
