

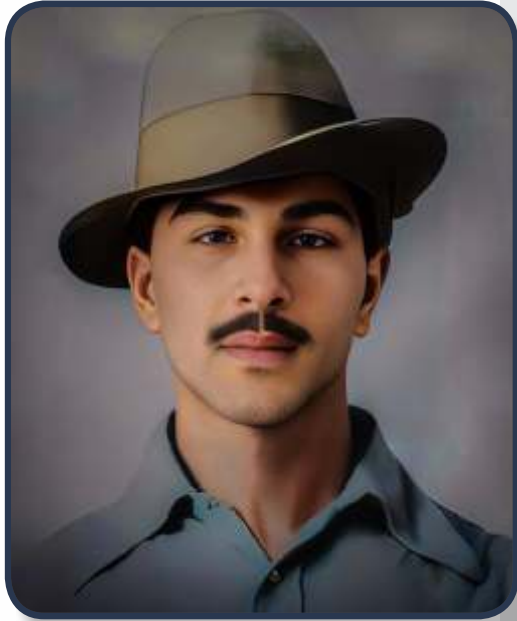

भगत सिंह सिर्फ क्रांतिकारी नहीं, बल्कि एक सुलझे हुए विचारक भी थे। अपनी फाँसी से पहले उन्होंने जेल में विद्यार्थियों के नाम पत्र में संदेश दिया था कि ‘इस समय हम नौजवानों से यह नहीं कह रहे हैं कि वे बम और पिस्तौल उठावें। आज विद्यार्थियों के सामने इससे भी अधिक महत्वपूर्ण काम है।’ उनका यह इशारा देश में फैली अज्ञानता और गरीबी को दूर करके भारत को एक ताकतवर राष्ट्र बनाने की ओर था इसीलिए उन्होंने कहा कि ‘वे (विद्यार्थी) पढ़ें और जरूर पढ़ें’ हम सब जानते हैं कि ८ अप्रैल १९२९ को दिल्ली की केंद्रीय एसेम्बली में बिना किसी को घायल किए उन्होंने बम फेंका और जान बूझकर खुद को गिरफ्तार करवा दिया।

२३ मार्च १९३१ को जब उनको फाँसी दी गयी तब उनकी उम्र सिर्फ २३ साल ६ महीने की थी। अपनी वीरता और साहस के लिए, भगत सिंह आज भी युवाओं के बीच आदर्श तो हैं ही पर साथ ही साथ वे विद्यार्थियों के आदर्श इसलिए, भी हैं कि छोटी सी उम्र में उन्होंने देश और दुनिया के बहुत सारे महत्वपूर्ण ग्रंथ, विचार, साहित्य, इतिहास और दर्शन पढ़ डाले थे। किताबें उन्हें पिस्तौल से ज्यादा प्यारी थीं, इसलिए वे आज़ादी को “मानसिक गुलामी” से आज़ादी भी मानते थे जिसका रास्ता किताबों से होकर ही जाता है। उन्होंने लिखा कि “क्रांति बम और पिस्तौल का सम्प्रदाय नहीं। क्रांति का अर्थ है आमूल परिवर्तन।”

भगत सिंह की शहादत के इस ९४वें वर्ष में विद्यार्थियों के आगे भारत-निर्माता की कई सारी चुनौतियाँ हैं। हमें पूरा विश्वास है कि शहीद भगत सिंह कॉलेज में प्रवेश पाने वाला हर विद्यार्थी भगत सिंह के उस सपने से खुद को जोड़ेगा। हमें यह जानकारी देते हुए अपार हर्ष है कि शहीद भगत सिंह कॉलेज अपने स्थापना वर्ष १९६७ से ही विद्यार्थियों के जीवन को राष्ट्र-प्रेम और राष्ट्र-निर्माण की दिशा में अग्रसर कर शहीद-ए-आज़म भगत सिंह के संकल्पों को ही पूरा कर रहा है।

On 22nd July 2024, the momentous inauguration of the newly constructed state-of-the-art infrastructure etched an exemplar of excellent development under the leadership of the Principal, Prof. Arun Kumar Attree.

INFRASTRUCTURE FACILITIES

Library: Knowledge and Learning Resource Centre

Library has been functioning as an integral part of the college since its inception. Library's pleasing ambience and modern infrastructure provides congenial environment for study and research. The college library has undergone a transformational journey from a complete manual system into a fully automated Knowledge and Learning Resource Center in 2010. Since 2010, the library of the college is equipped extensively with modern information and communication technologies and CCTV based security system.

Infrastructure: It is spread across 3 floors with total seating capacity of around 200+ seats, with reading halls on first and second floors of the library along with the stack area. The first floor of the library is newly renovated and is being supported by modern infrastructure and extensive signage. Special emphasis has also been placed on provision of comfortable furniture, adorning the space with portraits/pictures of notable personalities and proper illumination of the library to give it a completely organized and high-tech look. The second floor of the library has a classical and contemporary touch. CCTV based Security System is in place along with basic facilities like RO water, etc.

In order to make online resources accessible, to both students and faculty, exclusive e-resource centres are an important part of the library infrastructure. The students' e-resource centre is equipped with 22 systems, wifi connectivity along with Projector and Screen for screening of movies and documentaries. The library also has a fully air-conditioned, exclusive and separate e-resource centre for faculty members. The library has an Online Catalogue of its entire collection. Library is also equipped with Xerox facility.

Resources and Services : Library has a rich collection of resources, both in print and online, and has emerged as a launch pad for teaching, learning and research. The library has a total collection of about 70,000 thousand volumes on all the subjects being taught by the college, ranging from Commerce, Economics, Mathematics, History, Geography, Political Science, and Languages, etc. It also has a sizeable number of rare, ancient and not-to-be-issued text.

Some Hallmark Sections of Library

- **Centre for Shaheed Bhagat Singh Studies and Research :** It is a tribute to the heroes of our freedom struggle. It has exclusive material on freedom fighters, especially Bhagat Singh. The Centre was formally inaugurated during the Golden Jubilee celebrations of the college.
- **Light Reading Section:** This section has been set up keeping in mind the imperative need to expand our learning beyond the Curriculum in order to inculcate and cater to varied reading habits of students. This section has titles ranging from fiction, biographies, autobiographies, drama, cinema, travelogue, etc.

- **Voluntary Book Bank:** As part of the larger mission of the college, library has also created Voluntary book bank for needy students.
- **Periodical Section:** Apart from books, Library has an exclusive Periodicals section. In total there are 98 periodicals being subscribed by library. Apart from periodicals in 8 Subjects taught by the college, library also subscribes to good number of periodicals of general nature and 20 Daily Newspapers.

Apart from these varied print resources, being a member of Delhi University Library System (DULS), library provides access to various electronic resources through its exclusive e-resource centers. The footprints of library services rendered by its hard working staff are spread all over the college campus and have earned kudos, acclaim and recognition from its strong user community. Having its wings spread continuously, the SBSC library is truly a happening place.



COMPUTER LABS

- The computerization committee and IT Cell of the college are committed to the best IT infrastructure in the college for the best teaching-learning-research activities. Here are the details of tasks completed and the vision for the forthcoming year. 1. Established 5 new computer labs for the students of the commerce and mathematics departments. A total of 60 All-in-one (AIO) computers with the latest specifications have been already installed in these labs, while ~90 more AIO computers shortly. In addition, these labs have been provided with up-to-date projectors and the necessary sound system.
- This year, two remote sensing labs and one digital Cartography lab of the Department of Geography have been provided with more than 50 latest AIO computers.
- Computer infrastructure of the admin and account office has been also updated wherever needed.

VISION FOR UPCOMING YEARS

- Upgrade all the existing classrooms with IT infrastructure, including high-speed wifi connection and projector facility.
- Setting up a dedicated computer lab/section for students with special abilities. past, present and future, the Kendra is aimed at making “Developed Bharat” a reality.

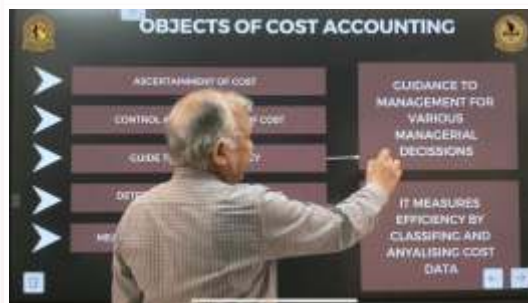
KNOWLEDGE DISSEMINATION CENTRE

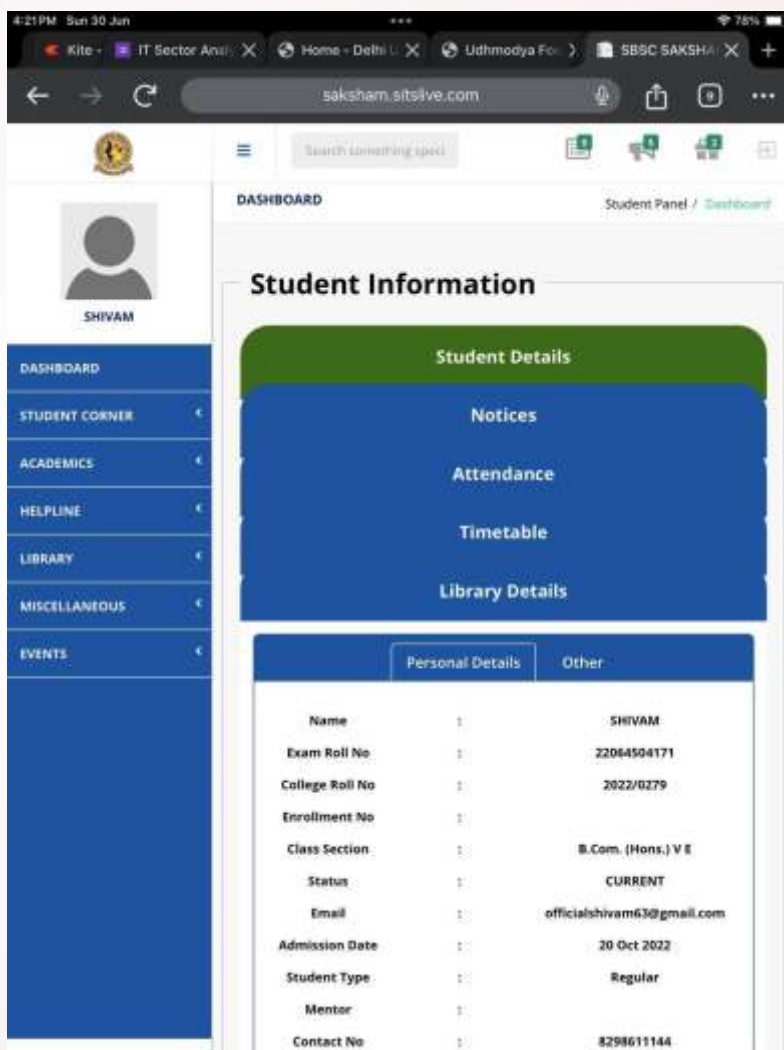

SEMINAR ROOM/ VIDEO CONFERENCING ROOMS

The college has five Seminar Rooms and one video Conferencing Room with modern facilities. SMART CLASSROOMS

The smart classrooms of an auditorium design have a capacity of more than 100 students, with desks having built-in storage underneath, the space of which can be used by students. These classrooms also have an array of audio-visual equipment, including a podium system, LCD screens with Wi-Fi capabilities, writing wall services, and an integrated sound system and cameras. The smart class's cavea shape enhances screen visibility, improves sound transmission, and fosters enhanced interaction with professors during lectures.



OPEN-AIR AUDITORIUM

The newly constructed open-air auditorium rests on eleven pillars on each side, providing sturdy scaffolding. It aims to ensure that the college's various programs are executed smoothly. Previously, this space was used as a parking ground, and unpredictable weather conditions like rain and intense heat frequently made it difficult for colleges to plan events. The structure of the auditorium uses novel construction material like rock-wool, which provides a suitable acoustic environment apart from maintaining a cooler ambient temperature. It is based on a budget-friendly framework ensuring maximum utility while guaranteeing long-term viability and sustainability.

SCM CELL UNDER CSD 2023-24

HARITHKRAM

Inaugurated on September 7, 2012 by the noted environmentalist, **Dr. Sunita Narain**, **Harithkram - the Environment Society of Shaheed Bhagat Singh College** has been relentlessly working on its motto **#BeyondTheBoundaries** to spread environmental awareness. It has constantly been engaged in promoting green and sustainable activities both within and outside the College campus. In nurturing young and budding environmentalists, Harithkram has always stood by its mission to make environmental awareness an inextricable part of the lifestyle of the youth. The members of Harithkram voluntarily contribute their time and brainpower through audacious media campaigns, events, contests and workshops.

Harithkram hosts its biennial flagship events every alternate year – the **Delhi University Sustainability Forum (DUSF)** and **Harithkram Model United Nations Environment Assembly (H-MUNEA)**. They are both inter-College and inter-University events which see overwhelming participation from college and university students, research scholars from Delhi and other cities in India, and also school students (in case of DUSF). During the pandemic, the society also initiated virtual events like **Cockatoo (Green Chats)** - a bimonthly assembly of budding environmentalists and celebrated a year-long **Biodiversity**

Trail that included several e-talks and e-interactive competitions for the participants. These and other e-initiatives of the society attracted many eminent speakers and guests from various institutions of national and international repute.

In the last academic session, Harithkram, in collaboration with the Centre for Indian Knolwedge Systems of the College, launched an inter-College, interdisciplinary research competition for undergraduate students, called **Undergraduate Research Aptitude (UGRA)**, spanning seven months, and culminating in a **National Seminar organized** on Earth Day. The focal theme for UGRA 2023-24 was “Ecological Consciousness in Ancient India: Life Then and Now.” Harithkram also launched a youth-centric environment assembly, called **Eco-Confluence** in 2024, a bimonthly open forum for participants to discuss burning environmental issues and brainstorm solutions to the environmental and climate-related problems plaguing our world.

The society observes the **World Environment Day** on June 5 during which an eco-pledge is administered to all in a special program organized in the college. It celebrates its Foundation Day in the month of September during which it conducts an eco-campaign on important issues related to environment as part of an awareness programme planned out by the Department of Environment under its eco-club activities. The society also organizes various workshops, training and nature trails and field visits for its members. Harithkram also participates in the global initiative started by WWF, the **Earth Hour**, on the last Saturday of March every year, by switching off lights in the College premises between 8:30-9:30 pm, and by organizing talks and movie screenings before the hour, and fun activities and a dark photography competition during the one hour.

Additionally, Harithkram regularly undertakes **nature walks, eco-trails and field-visits** to sensitize the participating students to the ground realities with respect to climate, nature, environment and the surroundings. In January 2024, Harithkram members went on an educational field-trip to Piplantri model village and Kumbalgarh National Park in Rajasthan. **Eminent environmentalists** like Yuri Afanaseiv, Vandana Shiva, Justice Swantanter Kumar, Kartikeya Sarabhai, Atul Bagai and Sumit Sharma have graced the various events of Harithkram.

Every Year, Harithkram invites students to join in their events to sensitize them towards the environment and their surroundings during important environmental days designated for creating awareness towards environmental issues. Under the skilled direction of its Convener Ms. Jyoti Varshney (Department of Mathematics), Co-Convener Dr. Komal Agarwal (Department of English) and Staff Advisor Dr. V. A. V. As part of the National Seminar, the Final Round of the Undergraduate Research Aptitude (UGRA) and a Panel Discussion were organized. The **Undergraduate Research Aptitude** Competition was designed as an intercollege interdisciplinary research competition for undergraduate students, a unique initiative in adherence to Mission Life and towards meeting the goals of the National Education Policy (NEP 2020), that is, to introduce research at the undergraduate level and align research towards global sustainable development and *Bharatiya Gyan Parampara* (Indian Knowledge Systems). The research competition was organized in five phases over seven months in a hybrid mode, and the final round was held in the offline mode on Earth Day.

Additionally, the Centre for Indian Knowledge Systems organized a **Certificate Course on "Understanding Valmiki's Ramayana: Values that Inspired Generations"** in the month of April 2024. Ms. Ami Ganatra, the bestselling writer and management professional, delivered the online course over seven sessions. Over 70 participants registered for the course. Shortly after, the Centre also organized a **Panel Discussion on "Ethical Values in Valmiki's Ramayana"** in collaboration with Dharohar, the Heritage Club, the panelists for which were Ms. Ami Ganatra and Prof. A.B. Shukla, HoD, BVP, IGNC.

The Centre plans to launch more such initiatives for the benefit of the students and the teaching fraternity in the upcoming academic sessions. In the upcoming academic session, the Centre will invite interested students to join the Centre in its mission to enthuse the College with the spirit of *Bharatiya Gyan Parampara*. Dr. Komal Agarwal from the Department of English is the coordinator of the activities and programmes of this centre.



INTERNAL COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE

As the name suggest, ICC is an internal committee of a workplace to receive and redress complaints of sexual harassment. In 2013, the government of India notified “The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act 2013” to foster an environment in which women’s safety and dignity are valued and protection from sexual harassment is ensured. The Act recognises the right of every woman to a safe and secure workplace irrespective of age or employment/work status. The Act makes it mandatory to set up an Internal Complaints Committee to deal with incidents of sexual harassment. ICC is a quasi- judicial body formed and work independently to work towards prevention of sexual harassment and handle complaints.

The Shaheed Bhagat Singh College (SBSC) is committed to provide a safe and conducive academic and work environment for women students and employees. We at SBSC are extremely alert and utterly intolerant to matters pertaining to sexual harassment and gender insensitivity. In Accordance with the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013, the College has constituted an Internal Complaints’ Committee against Sexual Harassment to look into complaints of sexual harassment by women students and employees. Any aggrieved woman may approach fearlessly to Prof. Poonam Sharma, presiding officer or any member of the Internal Complaints Committee

The Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) in its endeavour towards creating awareness about the committee and the law to create safer workplaces organised a workshop on Understanding and Implementing the POSH Act on 25th April, 2024. The Women Development Centre (WDC) collaborated with ICC in organising it. Ms. Monika Arora, Advocate, Supreme Court and member Delhi University Court discussed protection against sexual harassment at workplace (POSH), protection of children from sexual offences act (POCSO), ancestral property rights to women and many more laws that are meant to support women in her entire life. The workshop was well attended by students, faculty and staff. The seminar hall was a houseful audience spellbound throughout the session with invigorating, informative and useful for everyone sitting there.



VITAMANTRA- THE FINANCIAL LITERACY SOCIETY

Vittamantra, the financial literacy society under the IQAC of Shaheed Bhagat Singh College, University of Delhi, was established on June 11, 2024, under the convenorship of Ms. Shivangi Dhawan. CENTRE FOR WRITING AND COMMUNICATION

Under the sagacious leadership of our honourable Principal, Prof. Arun Kumar Attree, the college has established Centre for Writing and Communication, SBSC. The Centre is a one-of-a-kind space for the University of Delhi. It intends to develop communication, critical thinking, and research skills within the college community by working with a diverse section of students, teachers, and external experts and offering a multidisciplinary understanding of best practices in writing, communication, and research. The impetus behind the Centre was to ensure parity among our students and give each of them an opportunity and a relaxed space to work on their communication and soft skills so that their creativity and critical thinking can flourish unhindered by lack of confidence or exposure to the English language. This should enable our students to meet any challenges of higher education, competitive exams, research, or the global job market. To this end, the Centre has resolved to offer English language support to students comparatively unfamiliar with English through Add-On courses focused on English Grammar and core competencies of Listening, Writing, Reading, and Speaking, guided conversation/practice circles, personalized tutoring sessions and regular workshops/events on academic/creative writing, research, and publication.

Through any academic year, Centre for Writing and Communication, SBSC, conducts weekly Grammar Classes, wherein students are introduced to aspects of English grammar through a student-centric pedagogy, and Conversation Circles, wherein students practice their communication and soft skills during conversations on their topics of interest, under the leadership of a peer educator and a faculty member. In addition, the Centre also organizes informative and insightful workshops, talks and seminars regularly. The Centre has also developed a mechanism to offer each of our students the space to review and improve their communication pieces (e.g., assignments, papers, presentations, speeches, a piece of creative writing, etc.) or soft skills during one-on-one tutoring sessions, and will be testing and implementing this mechanism soon.



NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

The National Service Scheme (NSS) is an Indian government-sponsored public service program conducted by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports. It was launched in Gandhiji's Centenary year, 1969, aimed at developing student personality through community service. NSS was set up with the primary objective of developing the personality and character of students through voluntary community service. The CDMS regularly organized various events. which includes mock drills, lectures, short-term courses, community awareness programs, Inter and intra-college/university competitions, training, and workshops for students, staff, and other participants.

Last year, the cell have undertaken two minor research projects which also involved the collection of data at pan India level. A series of online lectures popularly known as “Explorify” were conducted by faculty members of our college to inculcate research skills, to develop interest and awareness about research among students and to develop their research acumen. The cell also conducted a comprehensive workshop on research methodology to equip students with the foundational knowledge and skills necessary for conducting research effectively. An online paper presentation event on 4th April, 2024 witnessed a participation of more than 150 undergraduate and postgraduate students from esteemed colleges all over India, the event was a resounding success. From thought-provoking discussions to enlightening presentations, the event was a testament to the power of collaboration and innovation in the realm of research.



PLACEMENT CELL

The Placement Cell of Shaheed Bhagat Singh College seeks to provide a platform for the students to gain corporate exposure and guides them towards a bright future and career. The student coordinators at the cell are constantly engaged in nurturing long-term alliances with current and potential recruiters, seeking quality human capital and furnishing excellent career opportunities to the students. During the recruitment season of 2023-24, the placements at SBSC saw a rise in the number of new recruiters with diverse profiles offered to the students. The Placement Cell was able to bring on board renowned accounting firms such as Deloitte USI, KPMG India, PwC India and EY GDS. Associates and unicorn start-ups like Zomato, Swiggy, to name a few, placed their trust in the potential of our students and recruited from SBSC for the first time. The recruitment season also saw an influx of more than 50% novel recruiters, with some notable names being Accenture, Intellipaat, RSM etc.

Apart from providing placement opportunities to the students, the Placement Cell also undertook a host of initiatives including the Articleship Fair for CA aspirants, CV vetting procedure for final year students, and organizing regular seminars and webinars to facilitate the students to become corporate ready. Further, the Placement Cell is associated with large firms for summer internships and events like Deloitte's GSM, D.E. Shaw's Finspire Fellowship, EY's CAFTA among many others. The speakers, in the session, highlighted various points such as Enhancing Financial Inclusion, Government-backed Initiatives, Early Integration in Education for Wider Fintech Penetration, Catalyzing Adoption of Fintech Post-COVID. The session was widely attended by over 100 students aiming to broaden their skillset and knowledge.

During the year the Finance and Investment Society has had an active performance and aimed at spreading financial awareness along with the development of its members. Through an active social media page, they were able to draw attention toward important analysis such as impact of hosting G20 conference in India, the economic impact of Ram Mandir, deep dive into fintech startups, integration of cinema with finance. For spreading financial awareness on the grass root level, they are actively involved in the preparation of Investment Reports which cover in detail about Nifty performance, investment suggestions, detailed explanation of financial concepts and much more. They also aim at inculcating a trading mindset in young students through their one-of-a-kind project Sikka which is a mock trading simulator working on real time prices.

Finishing the year strong with their flagship event CROMULENT, the Finance and Investment Society has tried to push their limits yet again this year. They formulated two extremely unique and never seen before competitions- Global Gambit and OTT Odessey, which went along smoothly. With participation and capturing interest of over 1000 students across the DU circuit as well as other colleges, they have proven their vigour and dedication to the field they have chosen.

Ecospire's annual newsletter, Arthanaya, launched its second edition with a theme of 'Rupee Going Global,' aiming to blend economics with finance on 19th March, 2024. Econotize'24, Ecospire's Annual Fest held on 2nd May, 2024 features an Economics Case Competition and A Stock Shock event, aimed at promoting economic principles and stimulating intellectual discourse among students.

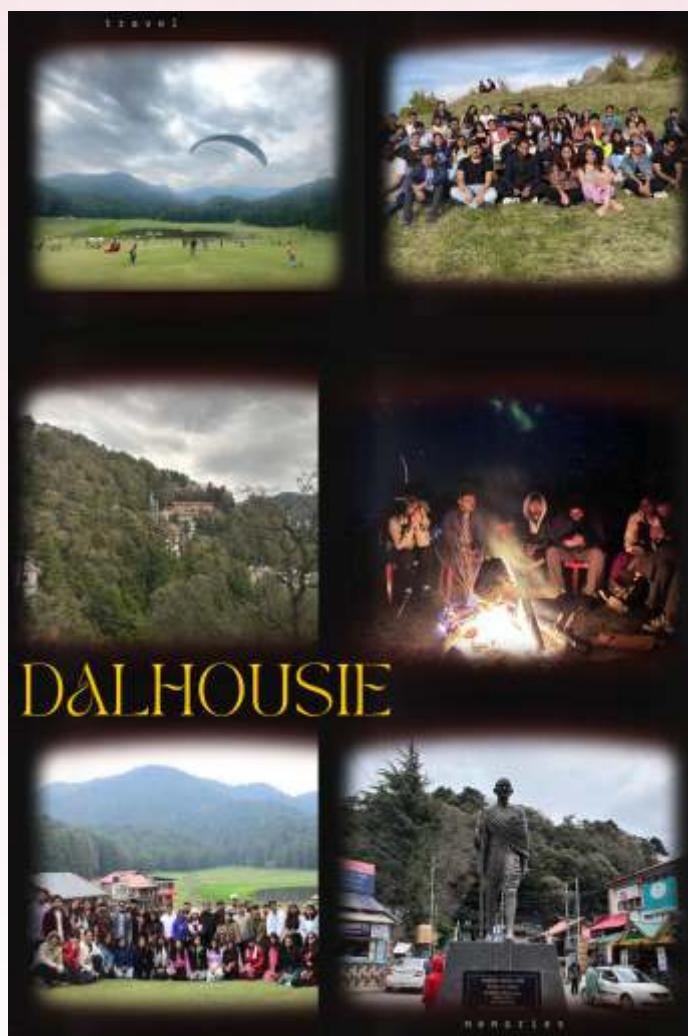

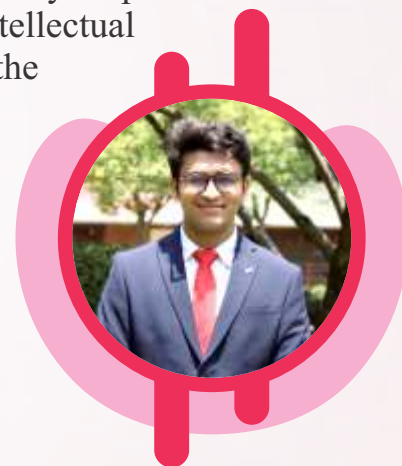
My 3 year experience at Shaheed Bhagat Singh College pursuing Bachelors degree in Economics has been as enriching as it could have been.

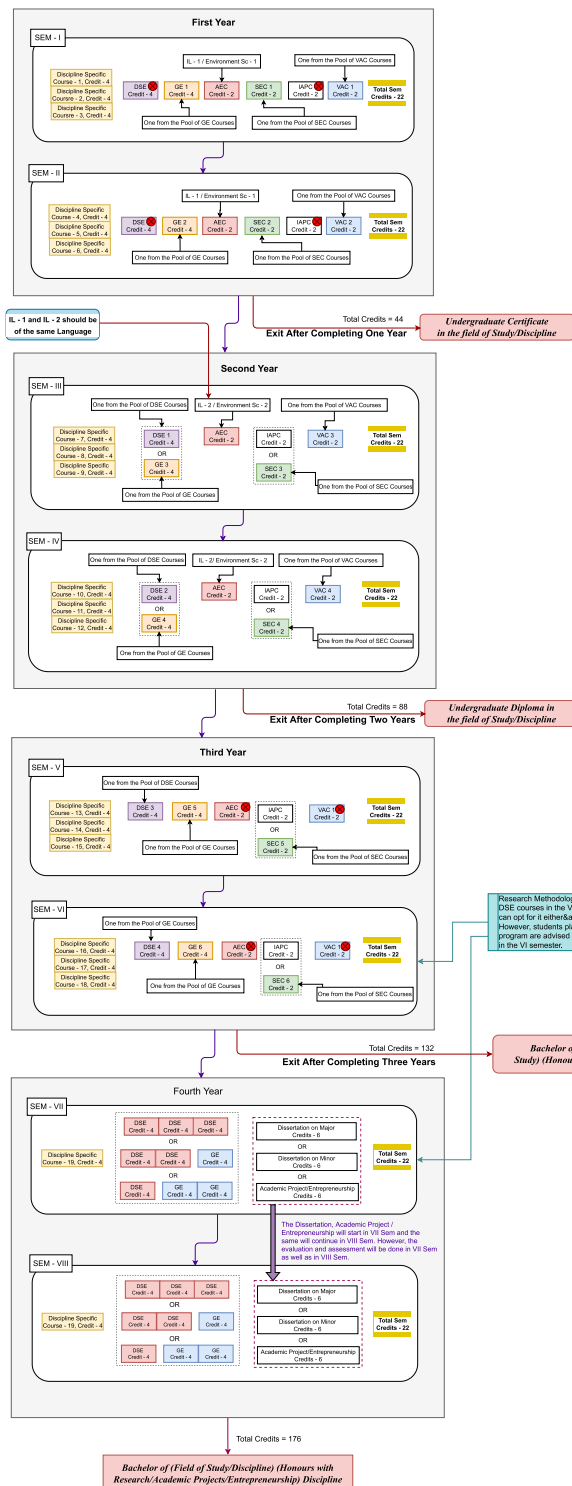

Example: B.Sc. Life Sciences programme with Botany, Zoology and Chemistry as core disciplines.
 Case I: He/She shall get Major in Botany, on successful completion of VIII semester, if he/she earns minimum 80 credits in Botany from Eight DSCs and at least Nine DSEs of Botany and writes dissertation in Botany.
 Advice: Students are advised to choose the discipline in which they wish to Major and must study at least Three DSEs of that discipline in the first three years. Like in this example, student must decide earlier and study three DSEs of Botany in the first three years as a maximum of six DSEs are available in fourth year. Similarly, if the student wants to minor in any of the remaining two disciplines, he/she should study DSE of that discipline in the first three years.

He/She shall get a Minor in Zoology, if he/she earns minimum 28 credits from Six DSCs and one DSE of Zoology. Or
 He/She shall get a Minor in Chemistry, if he/she earns minimum 28 credits from Six DSCs and One DSE of Chemistry.

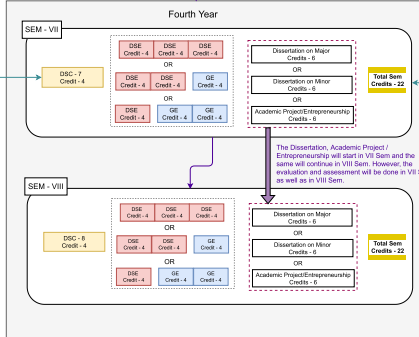
Case II: If a student doesn't do dissertation in Botany, but in other disciplines, say Zoology/Chemistry, or does Academic Project or Entrepreneurship, then he/she will not be awarded Major in Botany; he/she will be unable to get 80 credits, in such cases, he/she will be awarded B.Sc. (Honours) Life Sciences.

Students will have to choose one Discipline out of the three to study in the fourth year.

- 12 DSCs + 5 DSEs + Dissertation = 80 Credits

Attendance Requirement

No student will be eligible to appear in the Semester Examination, if he/she has not attended two-third of lectures, tutorials and practicals held during the academic semester as per rules and regulations of the University of Delhi. Exemption from this requirement will be as per the rules and regulations of the University of Delhi.

Anti Ragging Rules

- ZERO TOLERANCE FOR RAGGING (NOT EVEN FOR FUN) Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited within the premises of the college and any part of the Delhi University system as well as public transport.
- Any individual or collective act or practice of ragging constitutes gross indiscipline and shall be dealt with under the Ordinance XV-B and C.
- Ragging for the purpose of this, ordinarily means, any act, conduct or practice by which the dominant power or status of senior student is brought to bear on students freshly enrolled or students who are in any way considered junior or inferior by other students and includes individual or collective acts or practices which:
 - A Involve physical assault or threat or use of physical force
 - B Violate the status, dignity and honour of students.
 - C Violate the status, dignity and honour of students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Tribes.
 - D Expose students to ridicule and contempt and affect their self-esteem.
 - E Entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gestures and obscene behaviour.
- In case any student, who has obtained the degree of University of Delhi, is found under this Ordinance, committing an act or practice of ragging, he/she may be subjected under Ordinance XV to appropriate action for the withdrawal of degree conferred by the university.
- For the purpose of this Ordinance, abetment of ragging will also amount to ragging.

Ragging Related Complaints

Any student aggrieved in this matter may fearlessly approach Mr. Naman Jain, Convener of the Discipline Committee or any staff member of the college for speedy disciplinary action. Anyone found guilty of ragging may be subject to any one or more of the following punishments:

- Rustication from the college.
- Suspension from the college or classes for a limited period or Fine with a public apology.
- Withholding scholarships and other benefits.
- Debarring from representation in college events.
- Withholding results.
- Handing over case to the police, if need be.

NOTE: It is mandatory as per the Honourable Supreme Court and UGC/AICTE Regulations that all students fill in an Anti-ragging Affidavit each year. To make the process easy MHRD has developed an ONLINE facility. Affidavits can be filled ONLINE at: www.amanmovement.org & www.antiragging.in. The student is required to submit this affidavit in the college within 1 month of close of admission.

Code of Conduct

1. Students are expected to maintain a high standard of discipline and shall endeavour to promote the honour of the college and to inculcate healthy fellow feelings.
2. Student against whom disciplinary action has been taken will not be allowed to contest elections also.
3. Student shall refrain from:

For any of the above offences students are liable to punishment which may amount to fine, suspension or even expulsion from the college.

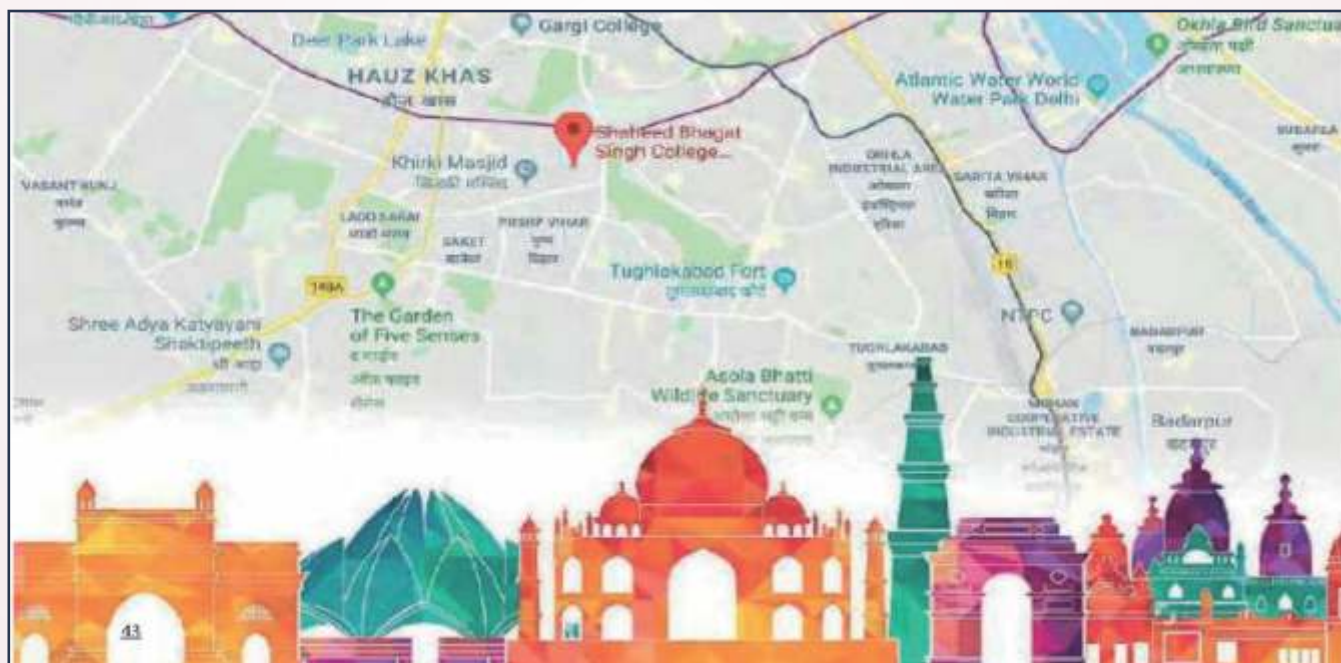
LOCATION: SHAHEED BHAGAT SINGH COLLEGE, NEW DELHI
