Regarding Generic Elective Courses (GEC), Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), Value Addition Courses (VAC), & Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) Subject Registration on the Saksham/ERP Portal for Semester II (Academic Session 2024-25)

This is to inform all the students of Semester II to complete their subject registration for **Generic Elective Courses (GEC), Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC), Value Addition Courses (VAC), & Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC)** on the Saksham (ERP) Portal Login Page (<https://saksham.sitslive.com/Login>).

- Guidelines of GE are attached at the end of this notice in the annexure (Annexure 1).
- Guidelines of SEC/VAC/AEC are attached at the end of this notice in the annexure (Annexure 2).

Students are advised to fill in their GEC, SEC, VAC and AEC preferences after reading the guidelines and the syllabi carefully. No changes will be allowed after the selection of these subjects by the students.

Therefore, all Semester II students must complete their subject registration by **26th January 2025, 11:59 PM.**

If students do not register for their subjects, the college will allocate these subjects at its discretion, and no requests for changes in the allotted subjects will be entertained after the due date.

GEC Guidelines, SEMESTER II, 2024-25

Guidelines for GE, Semester II, Honors Courses:

1. It is mandatory for all the students of **all Hons.** courses of Semester-II to choose their options of the GE papers that they want to opt for the 2024-25 session (Even semester, Semester-II). Link of the Saksham Portal is (<https://saksham.sitslive.com/Login>).
2. The students are required to give their preferences of the GE papers offered by the different departments for the Semester-II. **The College will allot the GE subject on first come first serve basis. Students will not be allowed to change their GE subjects at a later stage. Therefore, follow extreme care while choosing the options, as college does not guarantee for the allotment of the chosen preferences.**
3. The students of only Semester-II of all Hons. courses need to opt the subject of their interest offered by the other departments i.e., If a student is in Semester-II of B. Com (H) than the student will choose a GE subject of his/her interest from Non-Commerce Department only and Vice Versa. The students cannot choose the course offered by their own department. **For Example: A Student pursuing B. Com (H) cannot opt the GE paper offered by the Commerce Department of the College.**

Guidelines for GE, Semester II, Programme Courses:

1. It is mandatory for all the students of B.A. Programme, Semester II, to study the GE paper **“English Language Through Literature- I”** compulsorily. However, the students of the course combination of **B.A. (English + History)** will not be studying this paper, they will be offered common pool of GE courses.
2. It is mandatory for all the students of B. Com Programme, Semester II, to study the GE Paper of Hindi Language compulsorily, depending upon their acquaintance with the Hindi at School level. Please note the following for your reference:

Name of the GE Paper	Eligibility
Hindi Bhasha aur Sahitya ka Udbhav aur Vikas (Hindi- A)	Studied Hindi upto Class XII
Hindi Bhasha aur Sahitya ka Udbhav aur Vikas (Hindi- B)	Studied Hindi upto Class X
Hindi Bhasha aur Sahitya ka Udbhav aur Vikas (Hindi- C)	Studied Hindi upto Class VIII

Also note that students who have **not studied Hindi in their school upto VIII class, will have the option of choosing the GE paper from the list of common pool of GE Courses**, for which they may contact Mr. Aman Verma (Convenor, GE) or Dr. Ranjana Thakur (Co-convenor, GE).

Annexure 2

Semester II

Guidelines for Skill Enhancement Courses, Value Addition Courses and Ability Enhancement Courses for Semester II

1) It is mandatory for all the students of all courses of Semester II to choose their options for Value Addition Course (VAC), Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) that they want to opt for the 2024-25 session (Even semester, Semester-II). Link of the Saksham Portal is (<https://saksham.sitslive.com/Login>).

2) The students are required to give preferences for VAC & SEC courses and register for their compulsory AEC. The college will allot the VAC and SEC subjects on a first come first serve basis. Students will not be allowed to change their AEC/VAC/SEC subjects at a later stage. Therefore, follow extreme care while choosing your options, as college does not guarantee for the allotment of the chosen preferences.

3) The student can choose any paper offered by the college.

4) Students are advised to go through the Syllabi of the Value Addition Course (VAC), Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and Ability Enhancement Course (AEC), before choosing their options. The Syllabi are uploaded on the Saksham/ERP portal for your reference. The video link for the procedure of registration of SEC/VAC/AEC on the Saksham/ERP portal is provided below.

5) Students cannot opt for the same paper of SEC/VAC in Semester II that they have already studied in the previous Semester (Semester I).

For example, 1: if the student has studied the SEC Paper “Digital Marketing” in the previous semester (Semester I), then he/she cannot opt for the same paper in Semester II.

For example, 2: if the student has studied the VAC Paper “Financial Literacy” in the previous semester (Semester I), then he/she cannot opt for the same paper in Semester II.

6) Since students cannot study any SEC/VAC subject which they have already studied in any of the previous semesters, it is directed to the students to give last preference to the already studied subjects. For example, if any student has already studied “Digital marketing” in the previous semester then he/she should give Digital Marketing as his/her last preference.

7) The students of BSc (Hons) Mathematics, BA (Hons) Economics, BA (Hons) English, BA (Hons) Geography, BA (Hons) Hindi, BA (Hons) History, BA (Hons) Political Science and B. Com (Prog.) will be studying Environmental Science: Theory into Practice – Part I in Semester II as their compulsory AEC.

8) The students of B. Com (Hons.) and B.A. (Prog.) will be studying an Indian Language in their Semester II. Shaheed Bhagat Singh College offers only Hindi as an Indian Language.

Please note:

- Hindi A is for students who have studied the language up to class XII.
- Hindi B is for students who have studied the language up to class X.
- Hindi C is for students who have studied the language up to class VIII.

- Hindi for Foreign Students is for foreign students who have not studied Hindi at all.

9) The students of BSc (Hons) Mathematics, BA (Hons) Economics, BA (Hons) English, BA (Hons) Geography, BA (Hons) Hindi, BA (Hons) History, BA (Hons) Political Science, B. Com (Prog.), Semester I (UGCF:2024-2025) are informed that if you wish to study any AEC Indian language (other than Hindi), you are required to send an email at sbsc.aec@sbs.du.ac.in mentioning your Roll Number, Course, Contact Number, and AEC paper that you wish to study in Semester II.

10) In case you opt for an AEC-Indian Language not offered by the Shaheed Bhagat Singh College, you will have to attend classes of that particular language subject in the other cluster college (South Campus) of the University of Delhi. The fulfilment of your choice depends on the terms and conditions set by the host college. Only classes of Hindi Language will take place in SBSC.

11) The student will be held responsible in case of any false/misleading information on his/her part.
