**Extension of Date for Subject Registration of Generic Elective Courses (GEC) and  
Discipline Specific Electives (DSE) on SAKSHAM ERP Portal for Semester VII  
(Academic Session 2025-26)**

This is to inform all the students of Semester VII that the date to complete their subject registration for **Generic Elective Courses (GEC) and Discipline Specific Electives (DSE)** on the SAKSHAM ERP Portal (<https://saksham.sitslive.com/Login>) has been extended upto **16<sup>th</sup> July 2025, 11:59 PM**.

All students are hereby informed that failure to register for their optional subjects within the stipulated deadline will result in the College allocating subjects at its own discretion prior to the commencement of the academic session. No requests for changes in the allotted subjects will be entertained after the due date under any circumstances.

Students are also advised that any shortfall in attendance arising due to non-registration or delayed registration of subjects shall be entirely their responsibility. The **date of commencement of the academic session shall be treated as the reference date** for attendance calculations, regardless of the registration status.

All concerned are strongly advised to complete the subject registration process well within the given timeline to avoid any academic or administrative inconvenience.

## Annexure:

### GUIDELINES FOR GE and DSE, ALL COURSES, SEMESTER VII:

1. The students of **all courses (both Programme and Honors), Semester-VII** can choose their options of the GE/DSE papers that they want to opt for the 2025-26 session (Odd semester, Semester-VII).
2. Students in semester VII will be allowed to opt either of the following:
  - **Study 3 Discipline Specific Elective\* (DSE) papers, or**
  - **Study 2 Discipline Specific Elective\* (DSE) papers and 1 Generic Elective (GE) paper**

\*(Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) is an elective course from the related discipline/subject. The Discipline Specific Elective has equal credit as that of core paper. For example, A student from semester VII, pursuing B.A. Economics (Hons.) will have the option of studying the DSE paper, which will be offered by the Department of Economics.

\*\*Generic Elective (GE) is an elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/subject. **For example: If a student is in Semester-VII of B. Com (H) then the student will choose a GE subject of his/her interest from Non-Commerce Department only and Vice Versa. The students cannot choose the course offered by their own department.**

3. The students are required to give their preferences of the GE and DSE papers for the Semester-VII of session 2025-26. **The College will allot the GE subject on first come first serve basis. Students will not be allowed to change their GE subjects at a later stage. Therefore, follow extreme care while choosing the options, as college does not guarantee for the allotment of the chosen preferences.**
