All students are hereby informed that failure to register for their optional subjects within the stipulated deadline will result in the College allocating subjects at its own discretion prior to the commencement of the academic session. No requests for changes in the allotted subjects will be entertained after the due date under any circumstances.


Students are also advised that any shortfall in attendance arising due to non-registration or delayed registration of subjects shall be entirely their responsibility. The **date of commencement of the academic session shall be treated as the reference date** for attendance calculations, regardless of the registration status.

All concerned are strongly advised to complete the subject registration process well within the given timeline to avoid any academic or administrative inconvenience.

Annexure

Guidelines for Selection of GE/DSE Papers for Semester VII (Academic Session 2025–26)

1. All students enrolled in Semester VII are hereby informed that they must indicate their preferences for Generic Elective (GE) and Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) papers for the Academic Session 2025–26
2. Students will be allowed to choose **either** of the following combinations:
 - a. Study **3 Discipline Specific Elective (DSE)*** papers, **or**
 - b. Study **2 Discipline Specific Elective (DSE)*** papers **and 1 Generic Elective(GE)**** paper

**Discipline Specific Elective (DSE)* refers to elective courses offered by the student's own department and carry the same credit weightage as core courses. For example, a B.A. (Hons.) Economics student will select DSEs offered by the Department of Economics.

***Generic Elective (GE)* refers to an elective course from a department other than the student's own. For instance, a B.Com. (Hons.) student must choose a GE from a non-Commerce department, and vice versa. **Students are not allowed to choose GE papers offered by their own department.**

3. Preferences for GE and DSE papers must be submitted within the stipulated timeframe. GE paper allotment will be made on a **first-come, first-served** basis. Once allotted, no changes in GE subjects will be permitted.
4. Students are advised to exercise utmost care while selecting their preferences, as the college does **not guarantee allotment** of the selected GE/DSE papers.
5. All students who have **not studied the Research Methodology course in Semester VI** are **required to opt for it as one of their Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) papers** in Semester VII. Students who have already completed the Research Methodology course in Semester VI are exempted from repeating it and may select **another DSE paper** in its place.
6. For students enrolled in **Programme courses**, **DSE papers will be allotted to them on the basis of their selected major and minor subject combinations.**
7. Students are strongly advised to review the **pre-requisites** for certain DSE papers before submitting their choices. A list of DSE papers along with the relevant prerequisites is provided below for reference:

B.A. (H) Economics	Law and Economics	Intermediate Microeconomics II (ECON010)
B. Sc.(H) Mathematics	Advanced Differential Equations	Multivariate Calculus, Ordinary and Partial Differential Equations
	Fundamentals of Topology	Metric Spaces
	Information Theory and Coding	Probability and Statistics, Linear Algebra
B.Com.(Hons)	Business Research Methodology	Pass in class 12th with Mathematics / Accountancy
