SEC, VAC, & AEC Courses

Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) are designed to provide students across all disciplines with practical training, competencies, and specialized skills. These courses offer hands-on experience and are selected from a curated pool of skill-based instruction. Each discipline may offer its own SECs, with some courses available exclusively to students within the discipline, while others are open to students from various fields. Students are required to complete a different SEC each semester up to Semester VI.

Value Addition Courses (VAC) consist of a common pool of courses offered by various disciplines, aimed at fostering holistic personality development. These courses emphasize the inculcation of ethical, cultural, and constitutional values, alongside critical thinking, Indian Knowledge Systems, scientific temperament, communication skills, creative writing, presentation skills, physical education, and teamwork. VACs contribute to the all-round development of students, with a different course required each semester until Semester IV.

Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) focus on enhancing students' knowledge in key areas of study. These courses include Language and Literature (Indian Language Courses I & II) and Environmental Science: Theory into Practice (EVS Courses I & II), both of which are mandatory for all disciplines. The college shall be offering the following subjects/papers as ability enhancement courses (AEC):

Guidelines for Skill Enhancement Courses, Value Addition Courses and Ability Enhancement Courses for Semester-I

- 1) It is mandatory for all the students of all courses of Semester I to choose their options for Value Addition Course (VAC), Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) that they want to opt for the 2025-26 session (Odd semester, Semester-I).
- 2) The students are required to give preferences for VAC & SEC courses and register for their compulsory AEC. The college will allot the VAC and SEC subjects on a first come first serve basis. Students will not be allowed to change their AEC/VAC/SEC subjects at a later stage. **Therefore, follow extreme care while choosing your options, as college does not guarantee for the allotment of the chosen preferences.**
- 3) The student can choose any paper offered by any department.
- 4) Students are advised to go through the Syllabi of the Value Addition Course (VAC), Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) and Ability Enhancement Course (AEC), before choosing their options. The Syllabi are uploaded on the Saksham/ERP portal for your reference. The video link for the procedure of registration of SEC/VAC/AEC on the Saksham/ERP portal is provided at the end of this document.

- 1) It is mandatory for all the students of all courses of Semester I to choose their options for Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) that they want to opt for the 2025-26 session (Odd semester, Semester-I).
- 2) The students are required to give their preferences of SEC from the subject list (displayed below and visible on the Saksham Portal). The college will allot the SEC subjects on a first come first serve basis. Students will not be allowed to change their SEC subjects at a later stage. Therefore, the students should follow extreme care while choosing their options, as college does not guarantee allotment of the chosen preferences.
- 3) Students are advised to go through the syllabi of the Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) before choosing their options. The syllabi are uploaded on the Saksham portal for your reference.
- 4) The student will be held responsible in case of any false/misleading information on his/her part.

- 1) It is mandatory for all the students of all courses of Semester I to study one Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) in 2025-26 session (Semester-I).
- 2) Students are advised to go through the Syllabi of the Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC). The Syllabi are uploaded on the portal for your reference.
- 3) The students of **B. Com (Hons.) and B.A. (Program)** Semester I (UGCF:2025-2026) are informed that they will study Environmental Science: Theory into Practice –I as their compulsory AEC.

- 4) Students of **B.Sc. (Hons) Mathematics, B.A. (Hons) Economics, B.A. (Hons) English, B.A. (Hons) Geography, B.A. (Hons) Hindi, B.A. (Hons) History, B.A. (Hons) Political Science, B. Com Program**, Semester I (UGCF:2025-2026) are informed that will study an Indian Language-I as their compulsory AEC. Shaheed Bhagat Singh College offers only Hindi as AEC Indian Language on the following basis:

- **Hindi A** (For the students who have studied Hindi upto Class XII)
- **Hindi B** (For the students who have studied Hindi upto Class X)

- **Hindi C** (For the students who have studied Hindi upto Class VIII)
- **Hindi D:** Hindi For Foreign Students (For foreign students who have not studied Hindi Before)
- **Hindi E** (For the Indian students who have not studied Hindi upto class VIII)

5) Semester I students are informed that if they wish to study any AEC Indian language (other than Hindi), they are required to send an email at sbsc.aec@sbs.du.ac.in mentioning your Roll Number, Course, Contact Number, and AEC paper that you wish to study in Semester I. In case the student opts for an AEC-Indian Language not offered by Shaheed Bhagat Singh College, then he/she will have to attend classes in any other college belonging to the Cluster Colleges (South Campus) of the University of Delhi. The fulfillment of the choice of the student depends on the terms and conditions set by the host college. The following AEC-Indian Languages are available at cluster colleges: Sanskrit, Punjabi, Assamese, Bengali, Bodo, Dogri, Gujarati, Kannada, Kashmiri, Konkani, Malayalam, Manipuri, Marathi, Maithili, Nepali, Odia, Santali, Sindhi, Tamil, Telugu, & Urdu.
