- · Equations: Typed in MathType and numbered.
- Cover Page: Title, author(s), institution, contact info, course/year (if student). Max 4 authors are allowed. First author will be primary contact.
- Abstract & Keywords: 150-300 words with 4-6 keywords.
- Declarations: Include sections on funding, conflicts, contributions, data, ethics, etc. between conclusion and references.
- Plagia rism: Strictly prohibited. UGC guidelines (2018) apply. AI use is also prohibited. Turnitin or
 equivalent software will be used for this purpose.
- Originality: Only unpublished, non-submitted work will be published.
- Suggested Structure:
 - Abstract followed by Keywords
 - Introduction
 - Literature Review followed by Research Question(s), Hypothesis(es) and Objectives
 - o Methodology
 - o Results & Analysis
 - o Conclusion
 - o References
