#### Submission Guidelines\*:

- **Scope:** Original research in economics and related areas.
- **Format:** Submit in both Word and PDF.
- **Style:** Times New Roman, 12 pt, 1.5 line spacing (1 for footnotes/end-notes).
- **Length:** Maximum 6000 words (inclusive of all content).
- **Referencing:** APA style; use of Mendeley/Zotero recommended.
- **Figures/Tables:** Must be editable, embedded and properly labeled with sources.
- **Equations:** Typed in MathType and numbered.
- **Cover Page:** Title, author(s), institution, contact info, course/year (if student). Max 4 authors are allowed. First author will be primary contact.
- **Abstract & Keywords:** 150–300 words with 4–6 keywords.
- **Declarations:** Include sections on funding, conflicts, contributions, data, ethics, etc. between conclusion and references.
- **Plagiarism:** Strictly prohibited. UGC guidelines (2018) apply. AI use is also prohibited. Turnitin or equivalent software will be used for this purpose.
- **Originality:** Only unpublished, non-submitted work will be published.
- **Suggested Structure:**
  - Abstract followed by Keywords
  - Introduction
  - Literature Review followed by Research Question(s), Hypothesis(es) and Objectives
  - Methodology
  - Results & Analysis
  - Conclusion
  - References
