GUIDELINES FOR CANDIDATES

- Contesting Candidates can also cast their vote.
- He/she may visit the polling booth but not more than once
- Candidates will not be allowed to stay within campus premises after casting their votes or checking the polling booth
- Candidate may come and sit in the room when counting of votes will take place (post 1:00 p.m.).
- The followings room have been allotted for counting:
 - Room C-1: President
 - Room C-5: Vice President

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

- All students must carry a **VALID COLLEGE ID** card.
- The students of first year, who have not collected their college ID card yet, can collect it from admin desk near Gate No.1A on polling day by producing fee receipt and any one other valid ID proof, viz., Voter Identity Card, Aadhar Card, Pan Card, Driving License.
- The entry of the students will be allowed from Gate No.1A and exit from Gate No. 2A.
- The first semester students, who have deposited their fees till 9th September 2025, can cast their votes.
- The students will first cast their voted for DUSU candidates via EVM and then for the College Union election via ballot papers.
- In the case of College ballot, students need to put the stamp in front of their preferred candidates.
- If a student wishes not to vote for any candidate, he/she can stamp against NOTA.
- Students cannot choose both, i.e., candidate name and NOTA on the same ballot paper. This will be considered an invalid vote
- Students must ensure that they press the **end button** after casting the last vote on EVM.
- **Carrying mobile phones is strictly prohibited** at the polling booth and counting centres, except for members of the Election Committee.
- The students, who will cast their votes, will get **five lectures attendance** for the day.
- For the convenience of girl students, a dedicated **Pink Booth** has been set up in **Room No. D-1**, where **only girl students** will be allowed to cast their votes.
- The election results will be announced on the same day, immediately after the counting of votes is completed.
- **Winning candidates are strictly prohibited from organizing or participating in any kind of procession, rally, or celebratory march.**
- No indiscipline will be tolerated at the College premises.
