The Principal's Internship Scheme is an initiative launched by Prof. Arun Kumar Attree with the aim of providing students practical exposure and an understanding of large organizations function.

The first edition, Principal's Internship Scheme 1.0, began in June 2024, followed by Scheme 2.0, both of which saw increasing participation from students from morning and evening college. OBJECTIVES OF THE PIS

- To promote holistic, inclusive, and experiential learning in alignment with the goals of Samagra Shiksha, as envisioned in the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.
- To familiarise students with college functions through active engagement with academic, administrative, and outreach activities.
- To equip students with essential baseline workplace skills such as data handling, documentation, communication, digital literacy, and teamwork, within a professional academic setting.
- Align with the goals of the Vice-Chancellor Internship Scheme (VCIS) by offering insights into college and university operations.
- Instill a sense of belonging, responsibility, and accountability towards the institution.
- Enhance employability by preparing students to work effectively in large organizations.
- Empower students with certificates and stipends as recognition and motivation.

ELIGIBILITY

All bonafide full-time regular students at Shaheed Bhagat Singh (Morning & Evening) College, University of Delhi, studying in second and third year of any course/stream, are eligible to apply for the Internship program. Students must maintain regular attendance in their registered courses; the internship will not be considered grounds for relaxation of attendance requirements.

The selection process for interns will be based on:

- **Statement of purpose** (through Application Form) : A short write-up (250-300 words) highlighting the student's motivation, skills and expected contribution to the internship.

- **Basic Technical Proficiency** - Candidate should be tech-savvy, with working knowledge of Microsoft Excel, PowerPoint, and Google Workspace tools (evidence of prior use in academic or extracurricular work may be sought).
- Students should have no active backlogs at the time of application.
- **No Disciplinary Actions** - Applicants must have a clean disciplinary record certified by their department.

DOMAINS

The Principal Internship Scheme offers opportunities across a wide range of domains, each aimed at promoting skill development and experiential learning:

- **Office Management:** Administrative and Accounts support, record keeping and departmental coordination.
- **Video Editing:** Producing and editing videos for events, Gyan Prasar Kendra and college activities.
- **Graphic Designing:** Developing and creating posters, digital creatives and visual materials to support social media communication.
- **Library Management:** Book keeping, cataloguing, organizing and improving access to resources.
- **ERP & Website Management:** Managing the ERP portal, websites, app-related queries, timetable updates and providing technical support.
- **Marketing and Content Writing:** Creating social media captions, website content, annual reports, and YouTube communication, along with designing outreach strategies, student engagement activities, and promotional campaigns.

PERIOD OF INTERNSHIP

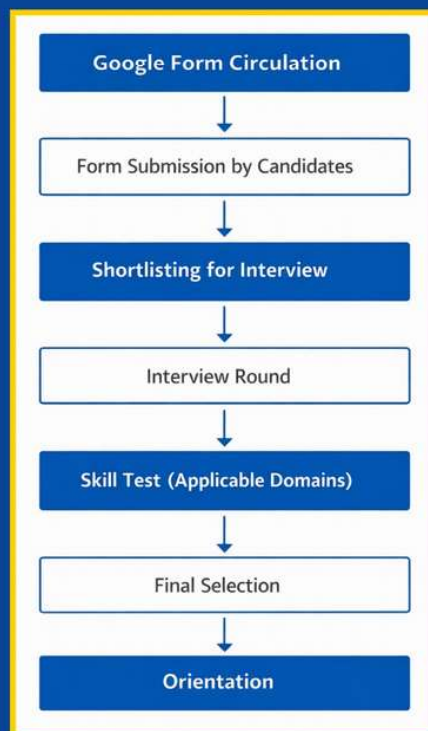
The internship will run for a duration of 3 months. This period is designed to provide students with practical exposure and sufficient time to gain skills in their chosen domain. Period of Internship may be extended beyond 3 months depending upon requirement and performance of the Interns.

INCENTIVES

Certificate of Completion - Issued by the Principal, subject to completion of the Internship and report from the Convener.

Stipend - Interns will receive a stipend of ₹4000 per month.
