**GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS CONTESTING STUDENTS' UNION ELECTION FOR THE
ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-2027**

1. Only those students who fulfil the eligibility conditions as per the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 22.9.2006 accepting Lyngdoh Committee Recommendations may contest the election. They shall abide by the code of conduct for election, which come into effect with the display of this notification.
2. No candidate can contest simultaneously for more than one post. In case, a candidate files nomination for more than one post then he/she has to withdraw the nomination from posts more than one failing which all his/her nominations shall stand cancelled.
3. Nomination Form can be downloaded alongwith Undertaking and Affidavit format/sample from the College Website, i.e. www.sbs.du.ac.in
4. No student shall put posters inside and outside the College premises except the handmade poster only on the **Wall of Democracy** inside the College. Canvassing with any form of printed material may amount to disqualification.
5. Incomplete nomination papers would solely be the responsibility of the candidate and not of the College and would be summarily rejected. Therefore, students are advised to carefully check that their nomination papers are complete in all respects.
6. Students having any academic arrears, i.e., failed in a Semester although promoted to the next semester are not eligible to contest election.
7. Each candidate must have carefully read all the letters, notifications issued in this regard and agreed to abide by the:
 - (i) Code of Conduct and other guidelines issued by University of Delhi dated 17.08.2026 and 03.09.2026 or time to time in this regard.
 - (ii) Lyngdoh Committee recommendations, as accepted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide its Judgment dated September 22, 2006 in the case titled University of Kerala v. Council, Principals, Colleges, Kerala and others
 - (iii) The Hon'ble Delhi High Court Orders dated 29.05.2018 and 11.11.2024 in W.P (C) No. 7824/2017 titled Prashant Manchanda v. Union of India & Ors.
 - (iv) National Green Tribunal's Order dated 18th July, 2016 in OA No. 402/2015.
 - (v) Delhi Prevention of Defacement of Property Act, 2007.
 - (vi) The Delhi Prevention of Defacement of Property Act, 2007 and NGT order dated 29.01.2009 in this regard and the Metro Railways (Operation and Maintenance) Act-2002 dated 17.12.2002
 - (vii) Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act 1984 and Order No.402/2015 of NGT.

Thereafter, all the documents shall be arranged in the following order, scanned, and compiled **into a single PDF** file and sent to email **studentsunion@sbs.du.ac.in** from **students official email id issued by college**.

- (ii) Nomination Fee Receipt amounting to Rs.1,000/- (non-refundable) (duly Signed). **The QR code for payment is attached herewith:-**
- (iii) Undertaking by candidate as prescribed in **Annexure-A** (Duly signed on each page by the candidate on a stamp of Rs.10/- duly attested by Notary Public/Oath Commissioner).
- (iv) Affidavit (**Indemnity Bond**) as prescribed as **Annexure-B** (signed on each page by the candidate and notarised on e-Stamp Paper of Rs.100/-)
- (v) Parent's Consent Form as prescribed as **Annexure-C** (on e-Stamp Paper of Rs.10/-)
- (vi) Affidavit (**Surety Bond**) as prescribed as **Annexure-D** (signed on each page by the candidate and notarised on e-Stamp Paper of Rs.100/-)
- (vii) Copy of College ID Card and Fee Receipt
- (viii) Mark sheet (Last Examination Passed).



The PDF file should be saved using the **First Name of the candidate followed by the post for which the candidate is contesting**. For example, if the candidate's name is **Nidhi Singh** and she is contesting for the post of **President**, the file name should be **Nidhi_President.pdf**.

9. All students are advised to strictly adhere to the schedule, eligibility conditions and instructions issued by the College from time to time. Any change in the above schedule, if required, shall be notified separately.

10. The candidate has to sign each page of the undertaking and affidavit alongwith the applications else the nomination is liable to be cancelled

Note: As per Lyngdoh committee guidelines 6.5.6

"The candidate shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office bearer, and two opportunities to contest for the post of an executive member."

This provision implies that a candidate who has previously contested an election for the **post of Central Councillor** shall be eligible to contest again in the Students' Union Elections, including for the post of **Central Councillor or for any other post**.

However, a candidate who has previously contested an election for any of the **Office Bearer posts**, namely, **President, Vice-President, Secretary, or Joint Secretary**, shall **not be eligible to contest again for any of these Office Bearer posts** in the Students' Union Elections, but he can contest for Central Councillor post.

UNIVERSITY OF DELHI
CODE OF CONDUCT
(For the candidates contesting DUSU
and

College Students Union Elections 2026-2027)

1. The union/representative body so elected shall only comprise of regular students enrolled in a full time course in the institutions of the University.
2. Undergraduate students between the ages of 17 and 22 years as on 16th August of the year of elections may contest elections. This age range may be appropriately relaxed in the case of professional colleges, where courses often range between 4 to 5 years (maximum relaxation of one year for the upper age limit for Professional Colleges).
3. The candidate should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election. Any pending paper(s) will be construed as academic arrear(s). Candidates failed in the preceding academic year and/or re-admitted in the current academic year will not be eligible to contest the election.
4. The candidates should have attained the minimum percentage of attendance as prescribed by the University or 75% attendance, which ever is higher.
5. The candidate shall have one opportunity to contest for the post of office-bearer, and two opportunities to contest for the post of an executive member. No candidate can contest simultaneously for more than one post.
6. Every candidate is required to furnish an affidavit, along with the Security Deposit, to the effect:
 - i) that he/she does not have any previous criminal record and has not been subjected to any disciplinary action by the University/College.
 - ii) that I have not failed in the preceding academic year and/or re-admitted in the current year.
7. The maximum permitted expenditure per candidate shall be Rs. 5000/-.
8. Each candidate shall, within two weeks of the declaration of the result, submit complete and audited accounts to the College/University authorities.
9. The Election of the candidate will be nullified in the event of non-compliance with any of the above rules/ guidelines or in the event of any excessive expenditure.
10. No candidate shall indulge in, nor shall abet, any activity, which may aggravate existing differences or create mutual hatred or cause tension between different castes and communities, religious or linguistic, or between any group(s) of students.
11. All candidates shall be prohibited from indulging or abetting, all activities which are considered to be 'corrupt practices' and offences, such as bribing of voters, intimidation of voters, impersonation of voters; canvassing or the use of propaganda within 100 meters of polling centers, holding public meetings, during the period of 24 hours ending with the



hour fixed for the close of the poll, and the transport and conveyance of voters to and from polling centers shall also be prohibited.

12. No canvassing shall be allowed in the College campus before 7:00 a.m. and after 2:00 p.m. Each candidate will have not more than 04 (four) bonafide students while canvassing in the College.
13. No candidate shall be permitted to make use of printed posters, printed pamphlet, or any other printed material for the purpose of canvassing. Candidates may only utilise handmade posters for the purpose of canvassing, in accordance to NGT order (OA No. 402/2025 dated July, 18 2016)
14. Candidates may only utilize handmade posters at certain designated places in the Campus, which shall be notified in advance by the College/University authority.
15. No Candidate shall, nor shall his/her supporters, deface or cause any destruction to any property of the University/College/ Institute Campus including the Website and Facebook page of the University/ College/ Institute for any purpose whatsoever. All Candidates shall be held jointly and severally liable for any destruction/defacing of any University/College property.
16. The use of loudspeaker, vehicles and animals for the purpose of canvassing shall be prohibited.
17. Excepting the voters, no one without a valid Identity card/pass/letter of authority, from the College Principal/ University authorities shall enter the polling booths.
18. Contravention of any of the above provisions of Code of Conduct may make the candidate liable to be stripped of his candidature, or his elected post, as the case may be. The College/University authorities may also take appropriate disciplinary action against such a violator.
19. The Hon'ble Supreme Court has made the provisions contained in Section 153A and Chapter IX-A 'Offences relating to election' applicable to Students election. Objectionable incidents, therefore, must be reported to the police, within 12 hours after the alleged commission of offence, for registering cases under relevant Sections of IPC.
20. There shall be a Grievances Redressal Cell for DUSU elections with the Dean Student Welfare of the University/teacher in charge of student affairs for college students union elections as its Chairman. In addition, one senior faculty member, one senior administrative officer and two final year students – one boy and one girl will be the members as the case may be (till the election results are declared, students can be nominated on the basis of merit and/or participation in the co-curricular activities in the previous year).
21. Notwithstanding anything contained in the aforesaid code of conduct, the directives of the Supreme Court judgment dated 22.9.2006 shall prevail.
